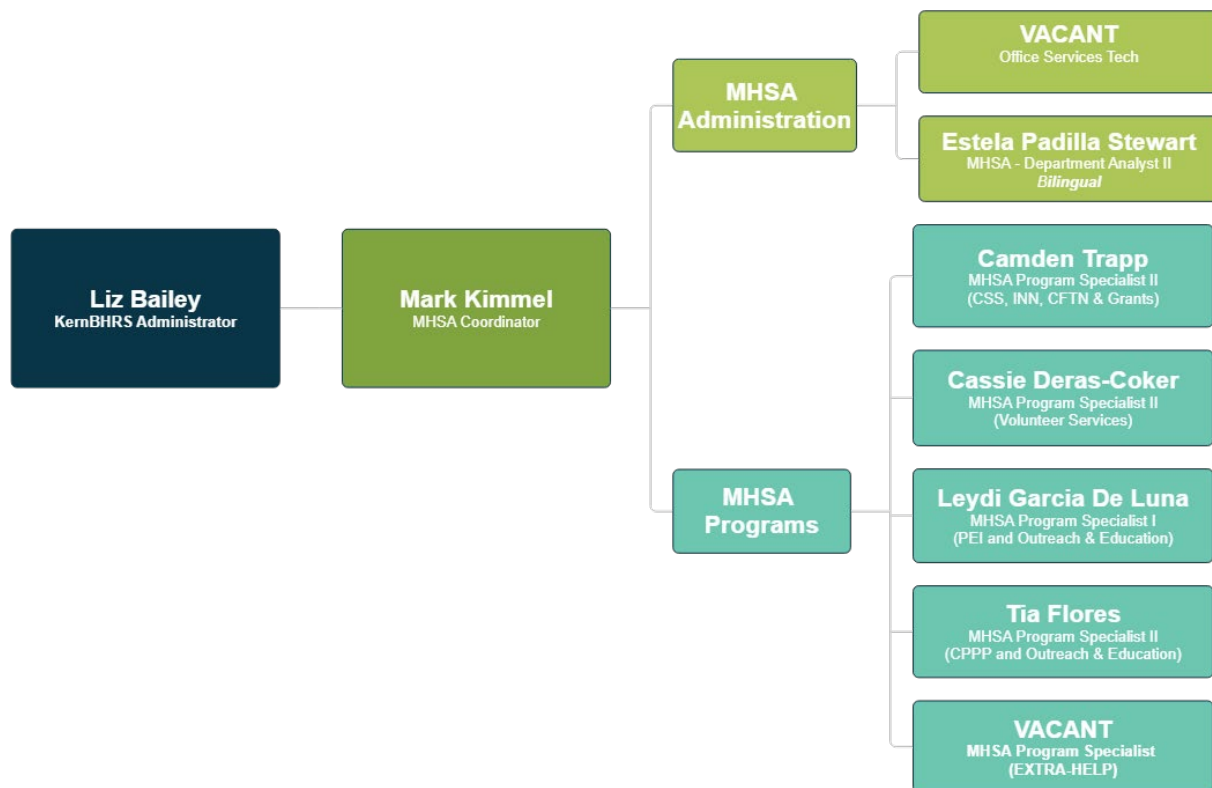


MHSA Coordination Team

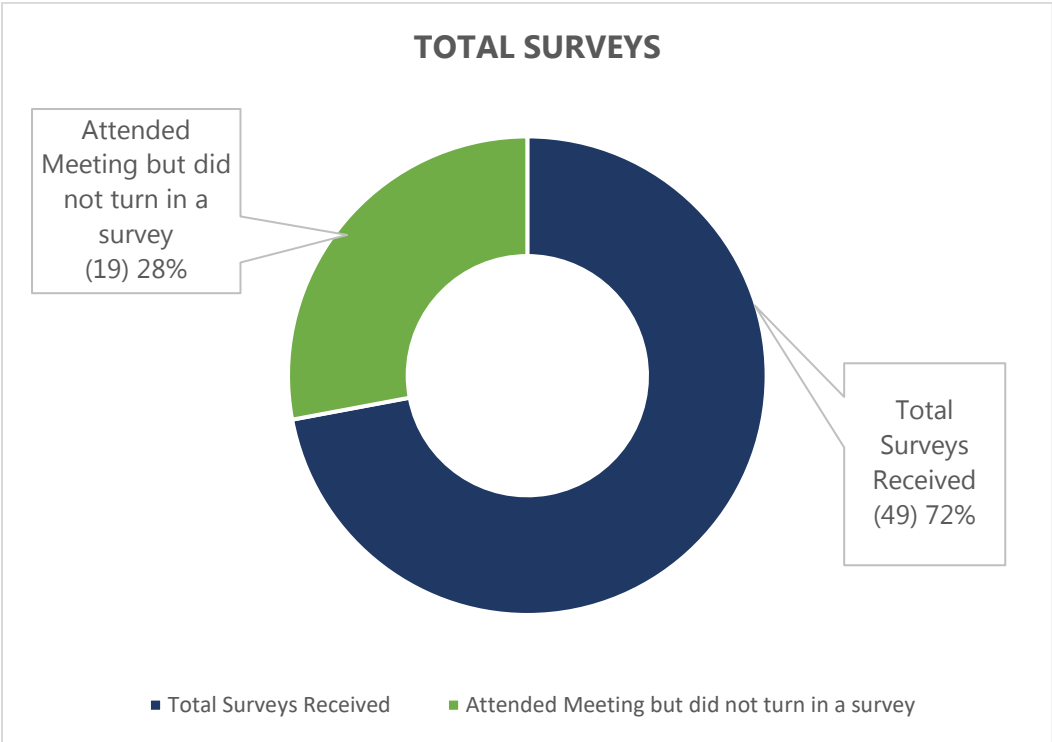
Stakeholder Education & Community Forums

During the 4th Quarter of FY 2023/2024, the MHSA Coordination team held 4 Community Forums.

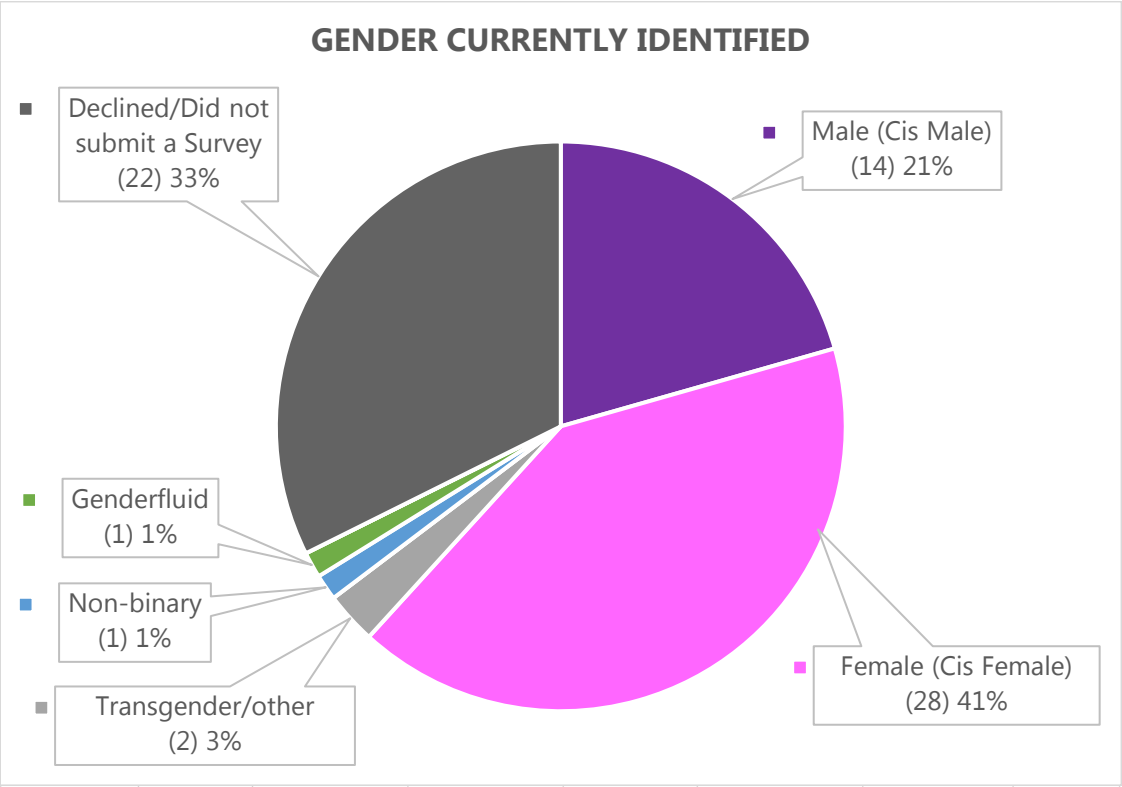
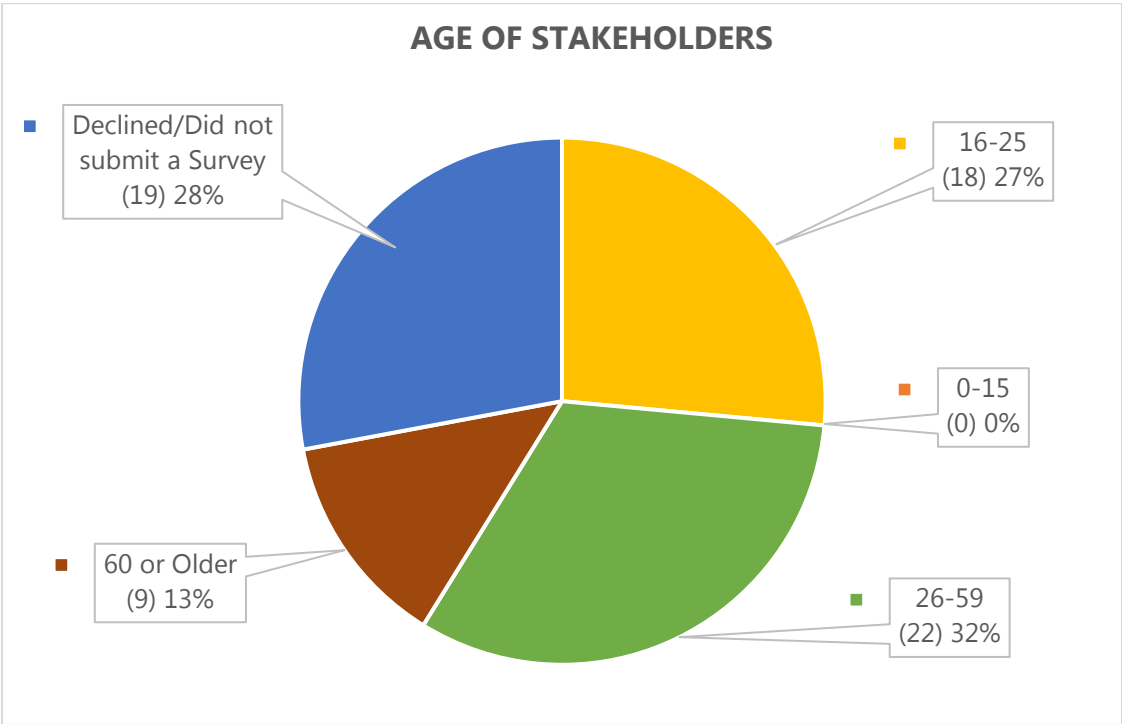

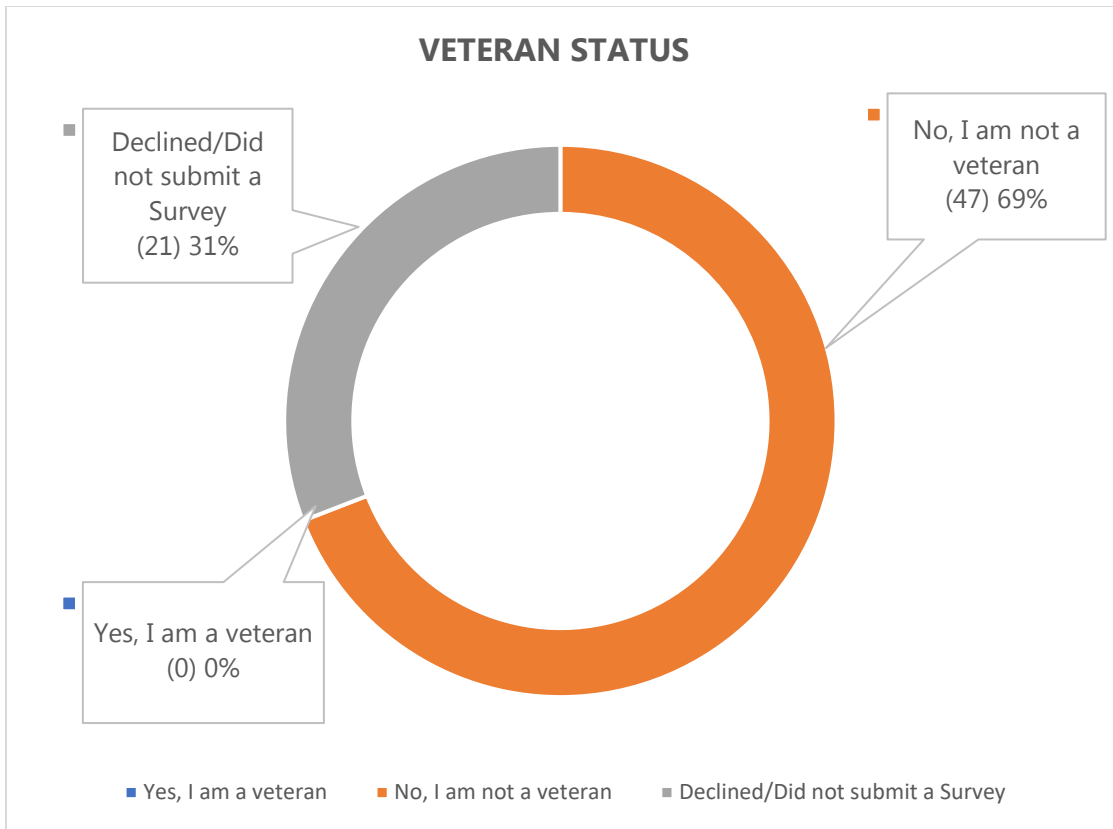


DEMOGRAPHICS OF STAKEHOLDERS

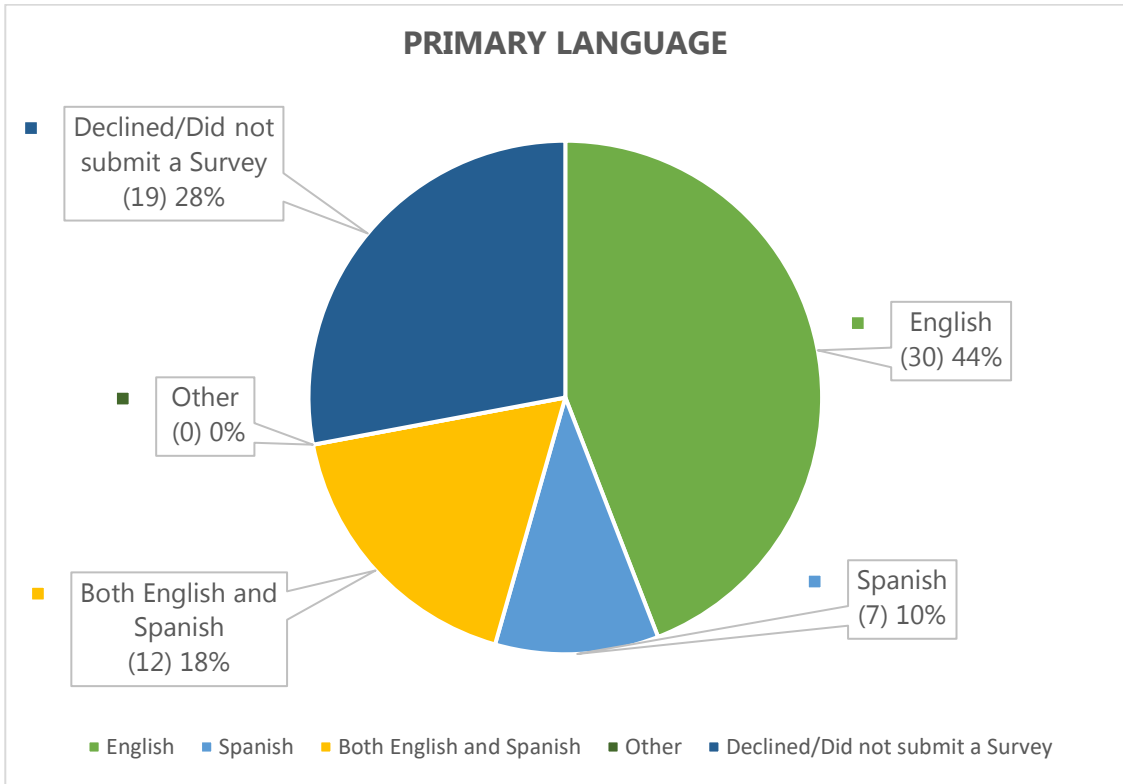

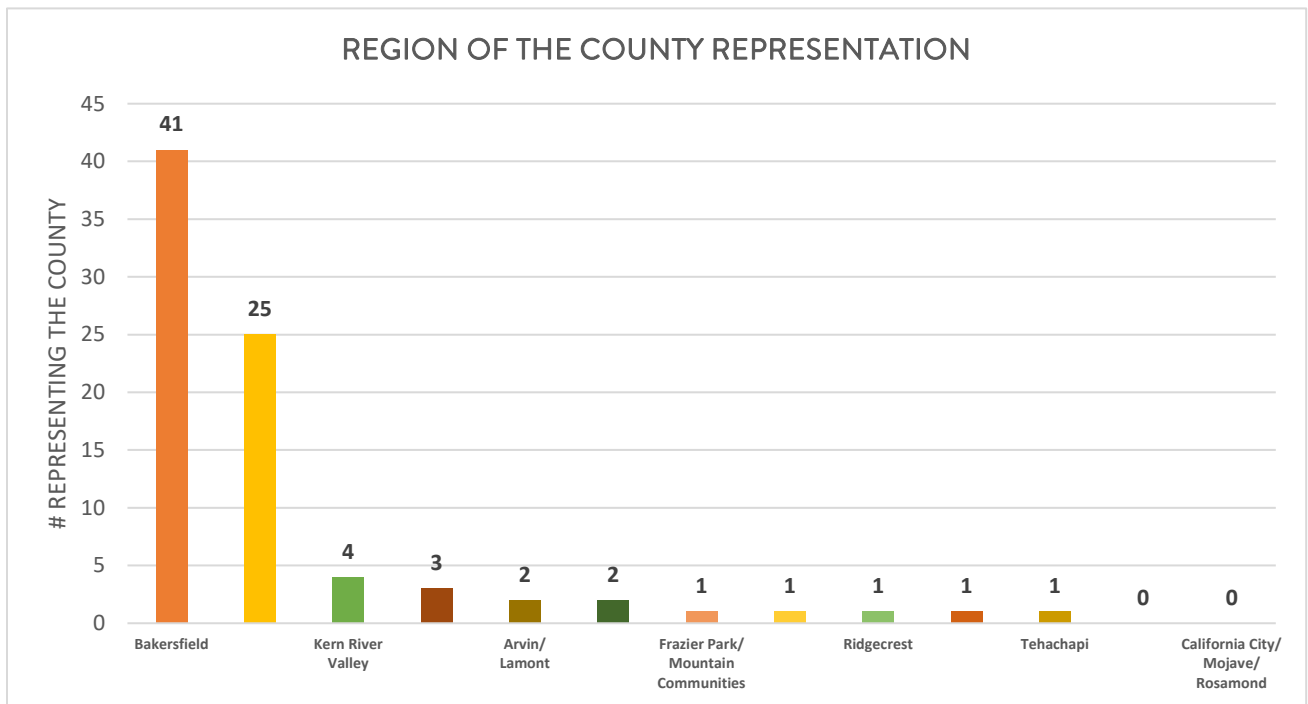
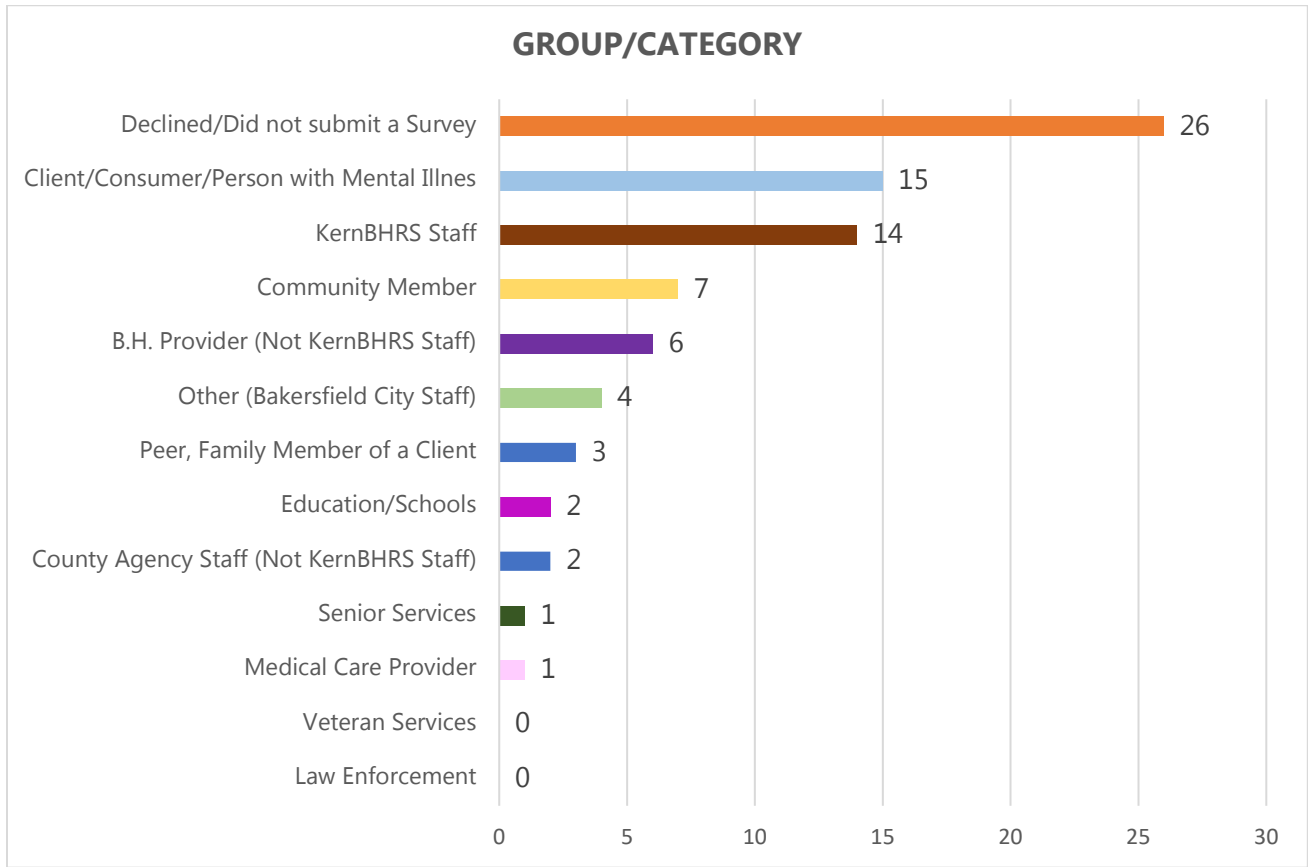
VETERAN STATUS



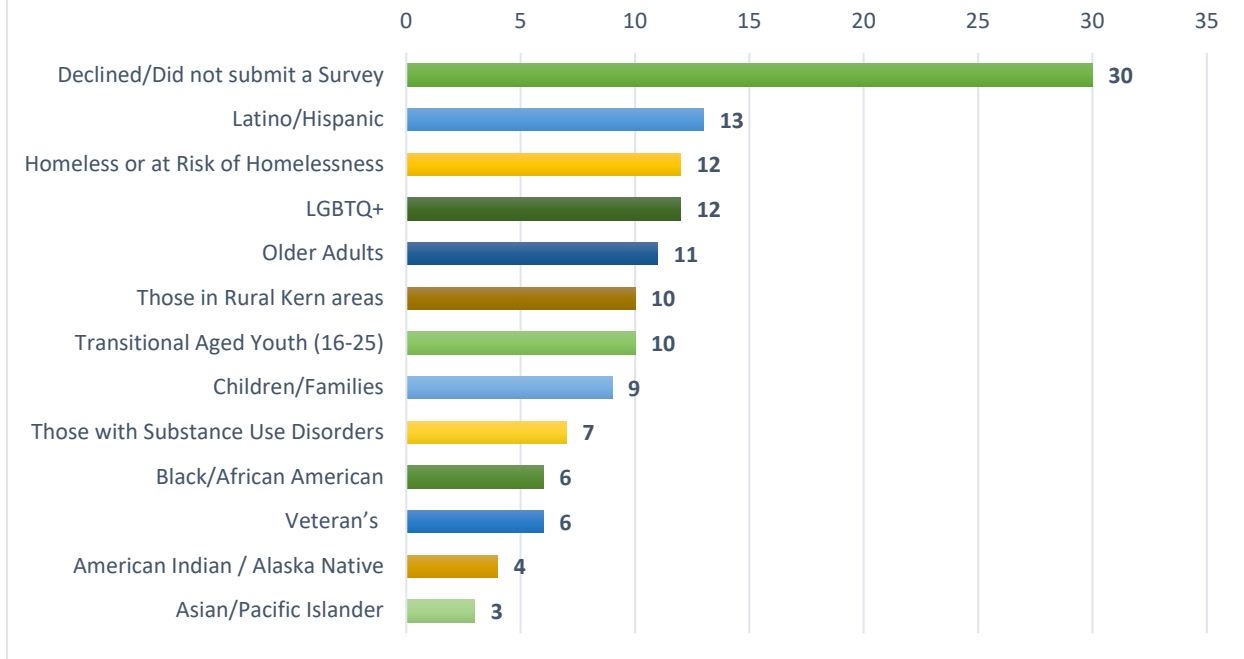
PRIMARY LANGUAGE











STAKEHOLDER REPRESENTATION
